

AWARDS SCHEDULE:

MATCH #1 SECTIONAL AIR PISTOL INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

PROVIDED BY: The National Rifle Association

WINNER: Gold Tone Sectional Medallion + 15 Award Points

2nd PLACE: Silver Tone Sectional Medallion + 10 Award Points (provided there are a minimum of 10 competitors)

3rd PLACE: Bronze Tone Sectional Medallion + 5 Award points (provided there are a minimum of 15 competitors)

CLASS AWARDS: For each class (Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, and Marksman), the following NRA Award Points will be provided:

1st Place: 9 NRA Award Points (with 5 competitors in each class)

2nd Place: 7 NRA Award Points (with 10 competitors in each class)

3rd Place: 5 NRA Award Point (with 15 competitors in each class)

1. If there are fewer than five (5) entries in a class, they will combine with the next higher class.
2. If there are not enough entries after combining two (2) classes, then they will be combined with the next higher class.
3. If there are fewer than five (5) entries in the master class, the competitor will shoot for open awards only.
4. An individual winning a place award (winner, 2nd, 3rd) will not be entitled to a class award in the same match. Such class awards will be passed down to the next eligible individual.

SPONSOR AWARDS FOR MATCH #1:

Sponsors furnish the type of awards they choose (except cash) for Match #1. (Optional)

MATCH #2 SECTIONAL AIR PISTOL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

PROVIDED BY: The National Rifle Association

WINNING TEAM: 15 NRA Award Points (5 to each firing team member) NRA will provide team awards for the open winning team, provided there are two (2) or more teams. Additional places in the team match may be given by the sponsor at his discretion.

SPONSOR AWARDS FOR MATCH #2

Sponsors furnish the type of awards they choose (except cash) for the teams(s) in Match #2. (Optional)

MATCH #3 NATIONAL OPEN AIR PISTOL INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

PROVIDED BY: The National Rifle Association

WINNER: National Championship Gold Medallion and 50 NRA Award Points

2nd PLACE: Silver Tone Medallion and 40 NRA Award Points

3rd PLACE: Bronze Tone Medallion and 30 NRA Award Points

HIGH WOMAN: NRA Lucite Award

HIGH JUNIOR: NRA Lucite Award

HIGH SENIOR: NRA Lucite Award
HIGH GRAND SENIOR NRA Lucite Award
HIGH JUNIOR WOMAN NRA Lucite Award

A High Visitor award will be given to any non-U.S. citizen whose score was either 1st, 2nd or 3rd place.

CLASS AWARDS: Separate awards will be given in each class: Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman

1st Place: 9 NRA Award Points (with 15 competitors in each class).

2nd Place: 7 NRA Award Points (with at least 25 competitors in each class).

3rd Place: 5 NRA Award Points (with at least 35 competitors in each class).

An additional 3 NRA Award Points will be given in each class for each 20 entries over a minimum of 35 competitors.

MATCH #4 NATIONAL OPEN AIR PISTOL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

PROVIDED BY: The National Rifle Association

WINNING TEAM: 3 Gold Tone Medals in lucite

2nd PLACE TEAM: 3 Silver Tone Medals in lucite

3rd PLACE TEAM: 3 Bronze Tone Medals in lucite

CLASS AWARDS: Separate awards will be give in each class: Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman

1st PLACE: 5 NRA Award Points to each team member

2nd PLACE: 4 NRA Award Points to each team member

An additional 3 NRA Points to each team member will be given in each class for every 5 team entries over 10.
