

## United Revolver Club of Sacramento EIC Pistol Matches

Service Pistol & CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Excellence in Competition (a.k.a. "Leg" Matches)

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate. Military active duty and reservists are welcome.

Date: Sunday Sept 3, 2017; Dec. 3, 2017 @ 12:30 pm (following the 1800 Bullseye Pistol Match)

Location: Sacramento Valley Shooting Center, Range 5A (See <http://www.sacvalley.org/> for directions)

Course of Fire: For Service Pistol EIC and CMP .22 Rimfire EIC Pistol use the 30 shot National Match Course of Fire (see Rule 7.3.1 Table 5, page 44).

Firearm: "Service Pistol," ".22 Rimfire Pistol" as defined in the Current Edition of the CMP Service Rulebook {see rule 6.3, Table 3 (pages 32-37), Rule 6.4 (page 37) or Rule 6.1 Table 2 (pages 28-32)}.

Entries: Limited to 30 competitors

Fees: For those shooting the 1800 - \$11 per EIC match. For Walk-ins: \$20 per EIC match.

Points are given to any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score (Rule, 9.2.7). Calculations are based on rule 9.2.6. All points are issued by the CMP.

Minimum EIC Scores – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.2.6 (top 10%) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline (see CMP Rule 9.2.7). MCS scores are:

Service Pistol: 250 out of 300

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol: 260 out of 300

Rules: In accordance with the current edition of the CMP Service Rulebook. All Service Pistol EIC Matches & CMP .22 Rimfire EIC Pistol Matches EIC Matches will be governed by CMP Rules.
