MATCH OFFICIALS:

ELIGIBILITY:

CRPA Membership is **required**. CRPA membership forms will be available the day of the match. Adult and junior competitors are encouraged, but not required, to be an individual member of the NRA or a member of a club affiliated with the NRA.

RULES:

Current [NRA Precision Pistol Rules](#) will govern except as otherwise detailed in the match program.

EQUIPMENT:

- .22 Caliber Pistol (Rule 3.4)
- Any Center Fire Pistol or Revolver (Rule 3.5)
- Any .45 Caliber Pistol or Revolver (Rule 3.6)

DISTANCE: 50 yards (Slow Fire); 25 yards (Sustained Fire)

TARGETS: B-6, Slow Fire Target. B-8, Timed/Rapid Fire Target.

CLASSIFICATION:

All competitors will be classified according to the NRA Classification System in individual matches and must exhibit their Classification card or Temporary Score Record Book at the Statistical Office. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master Class if they do not have an Assigned Classification (Rule 19.7). We will provide Temporary Score Record Books to unclassified shooters.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES:

Entries via email are preferred; match fees can be prepaid via check or PayPal. Prepayment of match fees prior to match day is preferred, and will garner a *\$5 discount* if prepaid.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Individual match entries must be received no later than August 1st, 2019.

POST ENTRIES: Entries received after August 1st, 2019, will be accepted up to match capacity.

ENTRIES LIMITED:

Entries are limited to 26 Competitors. Persons making entry within the time limit who cannot be accepted will be notified, their fees returned, and given precedence for our next match. Preference

is given for competitors entering the 2700 course of fire. Individual match entries will be taken on a space available basis.

SQUADDING:

All matches will be squadded. It is the competitor's responsibility to present himself/herself for squadding at the prescribed time (see "Times of Firing", below). Failure of a competitor to obtain his/her squadding tickets or to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP:

The course of fire for the State Championship is a full 2700 (Match #16, below).

ADDITIONAL MATCHES:

Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Service Pistol EIC and .22 EIC matches, as well as an NRA Distinguished Revolver match, will be fired after the .45 match. Course of fire for each match is the National Match Course.

AWARDS:

Awards for Matches #1 through #16 will be furnished in accordance with [NRA Precision Pistol Rules](#), General Regulations, A(6) and B(6).

1. If there are fewer than three entries in any class, there will be no awards provided in that class and all competitors in the lower class will be moved into the *next higher class*.
2. If the three-competitor minimum required for award purposes have still not been fulfilled, competitors will be moved up in class until there are three or more in a class.
3. A class will not be combined downward. If there are fewer than three High Masters, they will compete for **Match Winner** only.

The CRPA will furnish a State Champion "Bear Trophy" to the winner of Match #16, and a plaque to the High Woman and High Junior.

Additional awards may be announced on the day of the match.

Awards for CMP EIC matches and NRA Distinguished Revolver matches will be provided by the CMP and NRA, respectively.

FEES:

- **\$40** (\$35 if prepaid before match day) for the entire 2700 (includes lunch)
- Individual 22, CF, or 45 phases may be shot for **\$15** each. Lunch is an additional **\$5** for shooters not firing the entire 2700.
- Service Pistol EIC: **\$12**
- .22 EIC: **\$12**
- Distinguished Revolver Match: **\$5**
- Registration on the day of the match will incur a surcharge of **\$5**.
